

\$19k raised for family of late national silat coach



Sheik Alau'ddin, chief executive officer of the Singapore Silat Federation (Persi), handing an envelope containing donations to Titik Khusumawati, the widow of late national coach Mochammad Ichsan Nur Romadhon, at her home in Kenanten village in Mojokerto, a city about 40km south-west of Surabaya on Saturday.

Romadhon, an Indonesian who had been employed by Persi for eight years, died in a road accident on May 28. He was 34 and is survived by his wife - who sustained injuries to her right leg and head - and two young daughters, aged two and four.

A total of \$18,550 - which comprised a \$5,000 contribution from Persi and donations from members of the public - was raised.
